

## Questions:

## Directions:

### Airport to Hotel:

1. Starting on Lambert International Blvd
2. Turn L on Lambert International Blvd
3. Continue on Natural Bridge Rd toward Downtown/I-70 E
4. Take ramp onto I-70E
5. Take the I-70 Express E (L) exit onto I-70 Express LN
6. Take ramp onto I-70E
7. Take the Illinois exit onto I-55N
8. Take ® fork onto I-64 E toward Louisville/IL-3 N/ST Clair Ave.
9. Merge onto I-57 (S)
10. Take exit #95/Mt. Vernon/Ashley
11. Turn (L) on Broadway St (IL-15 E)
12. Turn (L) on S 10TH St (IL-37)
13. Arrive at the center of 62864 Mt. Vernon, IL 62864, United States

### Airport to Hotel:

1. Starting at the center of zip code 62864 on (N) 16TH ST go toward NORTH ST
2. Turn (L) on NORHT ST
3. Turn (R) on 10th ST (IL-37)
4. Continue to follow IL-37
5. Turn (L) on 1550 N (CR-1)
6. Arrive at the center of 62897 Whittington, IL 62897 15 minutes travel time.

The Vaughan Chapter PVA Trapshoot will take place at the Rend lake Shooting Complex June 20-22, 2008. The \$160 entry fee covers the cost of 300 targets (100 Singles, 50 pair Doubles, 100 Handicap), 12 boxes of ammunition, 2 breakfasts, and 3 lunches (served at the gun club) and 1 ticket for the Awards Banquet (additional banquet ticket may be purchased for \$30 each; additional meal tickets are \$10 each).

### Ammunition Policy:

If ammunition is taken, it must be used during the competition. Refunds will be made for emergencies only. This is the first PVA shoot of the new year. Book your room early as hotels fill quickly and these rates will not be beat.
