Directions:

From Airport to Hotels:

Take I-95 from airport to I-95 north through tunnel, and take exit 67B onto Rt. 43. After crossing back over I-95, go to the first light and take a left into the White Marsh complex. The hotels will be on the left.

From Hotel to Range:

From I-95 South, take I-695 West, toward Towson. Go to the second exit, which will be the Carney/Hartford Road exit. Follow Hartford Road about 1.5 miles, and take the first right after the Lutheran church. This will be Summit Avenue. Follow Summit until you reach Hill Top Drive and go left. Hill Top ends at the range.

The Colonial Chapter PVA/Keith Lewis Memorial Trapshoot will take place at the Carney Rod & Gun Club June 4-6, 2010. The entry fee is \$150 for all shooters (sitting or standing). This includes 300 competition targets on Saturday and Sunday (100 singles, 50 pair of doubles and 100 handicap), competition ammunition, breakfast and lunch on both days, and one banquet ticket. Guests may purchase additional meal tickets for \$12 a day.

Transportation:

Limited transportation will be provided from BWI Airport to and from the host hotel only on the days of June 3 and June 7 and between the hours of 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. You must make transportation arrangements with the Colonial Chapter no later than May 20. We can not be responsible for the transportation requirements of anyone not contacting the chapter in time. Limited transportation, on an established schedule, will be available on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday for practice and competitions. Please indicate transportation needs on entry form.

Welcome Social and Awards Banquet:

A welcome reception will be held Friday evening at the Carney Rod & Gun Club, 5-7 p.m. The Awards Banquet will be held Sunday evening at the Carney Rod & Gun Club.

Safety and Instructional Clinic:

An NRA-certified instructor will conduct a range and general shooting safety session on June 5. This session is **mandatory** for all novice participants.

Special Event:

Each participants registers and pays \$10. The minimum bid for anyone, including one's self, is \$10. Anyone not bid on agrees to purchase him- or herself for an additional \$10. Ties divide. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th places will be recognized. 60% of the winnings go to the bidder and 40% to the shooter.

Silent Partners:

On Friday, anyone wanting to enter into the randomly drawn silent partner options registers and pays \$10 for each event to enter (Singles, Doubles and Handicap). The payback is 100 percent and 4 places will be recognized at 50, 25, 15, and 10 percent. Ties will be equally divided.
