

Transportation:

Chapter will **not** provide transportation from airport to hotel, 92 miles, 1 hour 40 minutes travel time from St. Louis airport to hotel.

Transportation will be provided between the hotel and gun club on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday on an established time schedule. If you travel outside of the established schedule, you will need to find your own transportation.

2. Turn left on Lambert International Blvd.
3. Continue on Natural Bridge Rd toward Downtown/I-70 E
4. Take ramp onto I-70E
5. Take the I-70 Express E (L) exit onto I-70 Express lane
6. Take ramp onto I-70E
7. Take the Illinois exit onto I-55N
8. Take right fork onto I-64E toward Louisville/IL-3 N/ST Clair Ave
9. Merge onto I-57 (S)
10. Take exit #95/Mt. Vernon/Ashley
11. Turn left on Broadway St (IL-15 E)
12. Turn left on S 10th St (IL-37)
13. Arrive at the center of 62864

Airport to Range:

1. Starting at the center of zip code 62864 on (N) 16TH ST go toward NORTH ST
2. Turn (L) on NORHT ST
3. Turn (R) on 10th ST (IL-37)
4. Continue to follow IL-37
5. Turn (L) on 1550 N (CR-1)
6. Arrive at the center of 62897

- Singles: 1st & 2nd place in classes AAA–D
- Doubles: 1st & 2nd place in classes AAA–D
- Handicap: 1st & 2nd place in short, medium, long, and extra-long yardage.
- Top Novice Overall will be recognized.
- Top female shooter 1st & 2nd place.
