

Individual Awards:

- High Overall Able-Bodied Shooter
- High Overall Wheelchair Shooter

ATA/PVA assigned class awards:

- Singles – 100 targets, 1st and 2nd in each of the 6 divisions, AAA through D, gift card awards
- Doubles – 100 targets, 1st and 2nd in each of the 6 divisions, AAA through D, gift card awards
- Handicap by Yardage Class – 100 targets, 1st and 2nd in short, mid, long, and extra-long yardages

Other awards:

- High Women & High Novice – Special Award each

Team Awards:

Each team must have three wheelchair shooters. The Chapter Team Award will be given to the chapter with the highest overall combined scores from all 300 targets from each of the team members. Each chapter may enter as many teams as it wants, but all team members must be members of that chapter. **All prizes will be awarded at the awards banquet.**

The Calcutta

This option will be available as a separate event on Sunday handicap targets. Each shooter who is registered for the Calcutta pays \$10. Anyone can bid; minimum bid is \$10; the highest bidder wins the shooter. Any shooter who is not bid on agrees to pay \$10 as purchaser. The \$10 paid by the shooters and the total amount bid for each shooter will be the Calcutta pot. There are four prizes: 50 percent, 25 percent, 15 percent, and 10 percent, with 60 percent going to the bidder and 40 percent to the shooter. The winners will be determined by the scores on the 100 handicap targets.

Buddy Shoot

Following competition on both Saturday and Sunday, we will hold a Buddy Shoot. Mid-America Chapter will randomly select the buddies. Five teams will assume firing positions on the 27-yard line. The first team member will call for a target and shoot. If the target is missed, the buddy has the opportunity to fire. If the first shooter breaks the target, the buddy does not shoot. If the buddy overshoots on a broken target, a lost target is recorded. Each team receives two birds at each station. The team with the highest score wins the pot; ties divide.

The Silent Partner Options

These options are available as separate events on both Saturday and Sunday for each day's targets. Shooters pay \$10 to participate in each day's option. Those names are placed in a hat and drawn two at a time to make a partnership of two shooters. At the conclusion of the event, total score on all targets by both partners will be used to determine the winner of the Silent Partner pot for the day. There are four prizes, 50 percent, 25 percent, 15 percent, and 10 percent.

Directions:

Airport to Hotel

Head east on S. Airport Rd toward S Crossfield Rd. Turn right at W. Kellogg Dr. Take the ramp on the left onto US-400 E/US-54 E. Take the exit onto I-235 N. Take exit 16B on the left to merge onto I-135 N toward Salina. Take exit 16 toward E. 77th St N. Turn right at E. 77th St. N. Take the 1st right onto Wild West Dr. Take the 1st left onto Hopalong Cassidy Cir. End at the Sleep Inn at 1075 East Hopalong Cassidy Cir., Valley Center, KS 67147, 1-316-440-5050.

Hotel to Range

Head west on Hopalong Cassidy Cir. toward Wild West Dr. Turn right at Wild West Dr. Turn left at E. 77th St. N. Turn right to merge onto I-135 N/KS-15 N/US-81 N. Take exit 19 for 101st St. Turn right at E. 101st St N. Turn left at N. 47th St. E./N. Oliver St. Turn left at E 117th St. N. End at 3432 E. 117th St. North, Sedgewick, KS 67135.

Accommodations:

Participants must make their own reservations at the Sleep Inn. Rate is \$80 plus tax and is available until April 30, 2010. To ensure a room, make your reservations before that date at 316-440-5050. Inform hotel reservations that you are with the Mid-America PVA Trapshoot. If you require a room with a roll-in shower (5 available), you must ask the chapter to instruct the hotel to release that room to you.

Annie Oakley

Following the Buddy Shoot on Saturday and Sunday, we will hold an Annie Oakley shoot. All shooters line up on the 27-yard line. The first shooter calls for the target and shoots. If the target is not broken, each of the following shooters in the line takes a shot until the bird is broken or hits the ground. If the target is broken, all of the shooters that fired and missed are out. Every shooter that shoots out of turn or overshoots on a broken target is out. We will allow one buy-back for \$5. The buy-back monies will be added to the pot for the winner.

Lewis Class Partners

There will be a three-class Lewis Purse on each event. Cost to enter is \$10.

Class Purses

Singles and Doubles: On Saturday there will be class purses for singles and doubles. The entry fee is \$10. Money will be paid out for every seven participants in a class. Money will be refunded for all classes with less than three participants.

Handicap 25s

There will be a handicap 25s purse on Sunday. Cost to enter is \$10.

This includes 300 competition targets on Saturday and Sunday (100 singles, 50 pair of doubles, and 100 handicap), 12 boxes of ammunition (see registration form for daily pricing), the Friday evening welcome reception and the Sunday evening awards banquet. Complimentary lunches and continental breakfasts on Saturday and Sunday will be provided for each participant. Lunch will be available Friday at minimal cost.

Welcome Social and Banquet:

A welcome reception will be held Friday evening at the KTA Shooting Park, 5–8 p.m. The awards banquet will be held Sunday evening, beginning at 5 p.m., at the KTA Shooting Park.

Safety and Instructional Clinic:

Instruction will be available for participants who request it during the practice session on Friday. All **novices must attend** the Safety and Instructional Clinic on Friday at the gun club. Safety rules are posted at the range. Any infractions of these rules could result in your immediate disqualification from this tournament.
